## **PAST WORKSHOP**

## Classical Voice Workshop "Vocal Artistry for Voice Teachers and Singers" with Rhoslyn Jones

On March 24th, voice teachers and singers convened at Montclair Presbyterian Church in Oakland to attend a SFBAC NATS classical voice workshop led by Rhoslyn Jones. In addition to her vast operatic stage experience, Rhoslyn Jones is the newly appointed voice teacher for the San Francisco Opera Adler Fellows, she is on the faculty of the San Francisco Opera Merola Program, San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Chautauqua Institute, and the co-founder of the Bay Area Vocal Academy.

The first part of the workshop consisted in a presentation by Ms. Jones, in which she detailed her personal journey toward becoming an established opera singer and voice teacher. She explained how past voice teachers and mentors have shaped her teaching philosophy and her ethos in singing. Emphasizing the critical importance of advocating for early music education and nurturing a collaborative community among voice educators, Ms. Jones offered invaluable perspectives to all in attendance.

In the second part of the workshop, Ms Jones worked with four talented singers: Brooks Liang, Anastasia Miin, Katherine Nägele-Lin, and Athena Christine Palombi, accompanied at the piano by Chun Mei Wilson. Ms. Jones introduced a variety of techniques and tools to address specific vocal challenges, such as mitigating unwanted tension at the root of the tongue, addressing a dropped soft palate or encouraging consistent airflow throughout a phrase. Through Ms. Jones's guidance, the singers experienced tangible improvements in their vocal abilities, showcasing the transformative impact of her expertise within the limited timeframe.

In essence, the workshop was a testament to the transformative power of mentorship, collaboration, and expertise in nurturing the talents of aspiring singers and empowering voice educators. Thank you, Rhoslyn Jones, for an unforgettable experience filled with wisdom and musical inspiration!
