SFBAC NATS Workshop with Rhoslyn Jones

Join us for a presentation and workshop with this exciting artist! Equally at home on the stage and in the teaching studio, **Rhoslyn Jones** is the newly appointed voice teacher for the San Francisco Opera Adler Fellows. She is also on the faculty of the San Francisco Opera Merola Program, San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Chautauqua Institute, and the co-founder of the Bay Area Vocal Academy.

The in-person event will include a 45-minute presentation followed by a 1-hour voice class with three performers, concluding with a 30-minute Q&A session. It will be held at Montclair Presbyterian Church in Oakland, CA, on Sunday, February 4, from 2:30pm to 5:00pm.

From her website (rhoslynjones.com): Described as a "superb singer and artistic presence," Rhoslyn Jones has established herself as an important presence on the operatic and concert stages of the world. Hailed as "The delicious diva," Ms. Jones captivated the audience with her "unforgettably powerful voice" in her role debut in Vancouver Opera's production of *Le Nozze di Figaro*. "Ms. Jones is a joy to watch and reason alone to see the show."

Other career highlights include multiple roles at San Francisco Opera including covering the title roles in Puccini's *Manon Lescaut* and *Tosca*, Madame Lidoine in *Dialogues of the*

Carmelites, and appearing in Strauss' Elektra where Ms. Jones stood out as the "compassionate Fifth Maidservant, singing in a shimmering, ringing soprano." Most recently she appeared as Lisa in Tchaikovsky's Pique Dame with West Bay Opera, in recital with the Cincinnati Song Initiative, as Musetta in La Boheme at both Arizona Opera and Pittsburgh Opera." A special feature of her website is the blog, Diary of an Opera Singer: A Professional Soprano's Unfiltered Tell-All of Diva's Drama, and the Dayto-Day."

As a teacher, Ms. Jones seeks to instill classical technique through operatic, art song, and musical theater repertoire. Ms. Jones values a healthy, well produced tone that is even throughout its range. She helps to acquaint students with the function and importance of using their entire bodies as their instruments. Ms. Jones mentors young singers as individuals, using her wealth of professional performing experience on the world's great stages and high level of empathy and intuition to support singers in their growth as artists. Ms. Jones' students are regularly accepted into top conservatories and universities in North America and are frequent winners of prestigious competitions under her expert guidance.

These funds were established to honor revered colleagues, Page Swift, Kathryn Harvey, Edwin Barlow, and Eleanor Cohen. They support awards that may be given to outstanding contestants in the Spring Singing Festival.

The designation is as follows:

The Barnhouse Award may be given to students 18 and younger

The Dorothy Barnhouse High School Classical Award was established in 2015. Participating finalists entering the High School and Youth Classical Categories are eligible to win this award. They will be evaluated by esteemed judges to identify the winner.

The Swift Award may be given to students 18 and younger

The Page Swift Award was established in 2009. The award is given to a deserving vocalist in the High School and Youth categories for Musical Theater and CCM . Esteemed judges will evaluate the finalists during the Chapter's Student Auditions Final Round, and identify the winner.

The Harvey Award may be given to students 19-24

The Kathryn Harvey Award was established in 2009. During the Chapter's Student Auditions Final Round, participating finalists in all College categories will be evaluated by esteemed judges to identify the winner of the Harvey Award.

The Barlow Award may be given to students 25 and older

The Barlow Scholarship was established in 1995 as a tribute to Edwin Barlow, a local teacher, performer and NATS member who died in 1994. At the Chapter's Student Auditions Final Round, participating finalists in the Advanced and Avocational categories will be evaluated by esteemed judges to identify the winner.

The Cohen Award may be given to students who began lessons after age 35

The Eleanor Cohen Award was established in honor of Eleanor Cohen. The award is given specifically to a deserving vocalist who began studying voice on or after the age of 35. At the Singing Festival Winners' Concert, participating students will be evaluated by SFBAC Member Teachers to identify winners of the Eleanor Cohen Award.
