

## MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF TEACHERS OF SINGING FOR 2010

Sunday, June 13, 2010, San Francisco Conservatory of Music, room 207.  
Meeting was called to order at 3:10 PM by President Wendy Hillhouse.

- The Singing Festival went well; thanks to hard work by Festival VP April McNeely, her assistants Eric Howe and Teresa Cardinale and all the members who volunteered their help. The expense of the facility was much greater than we had at first anticipated; we received information about the expense at a date too late for us to change the venue; consequently we took in less money than we spent.
- The Fall and Spring workshops and the January Master Class were excellent. Attendance was lower than desired at each of these programs; Anja suggested that perhaps a questionnaire would help; also that more use of our phone tree might result in higher attendance.
- Several of our members will attend the National Convention in Salt Lake City. As President, Wendy will of course attend; also going will be Meghan Dibble, Audrey Howitt, Sue Field and Frank Ryken.
- Wendy has been asked to be an adjudicator for the NATSAA semi-finals. (At one time she won that competition.) She also attended the Singer Training Forum sponsored by Opera America.
- Oren Brown DVD: the artistic design was donated by Allen Green; the commercial firm of Disc Makers made 1000 DVDs. These will be for sale at our booth at the National Convention. Lucy Beck paid part of the cost in exchange for permission to sell her new book there; she will give 15% of her profit to SFBAC,
